he word koinonia has been translated and used in many ways, denoting partnership, sharing, taking part and most commonly, fellowship. At first glance, it can refer to a mere gathering of people. This, however, is not how it was meant to be in relation to the New Testament, specifically in its usage in the book of Acts. We find in Acts 2:42-47 a description of how the early church conducted their fellowship times and groups. The passage shows us that they broke bread, prayed,

shared with those in need and served together gladly! While what they did are, indeed, expressions of grace, it is good for us to know why the early church did what they did! Acts 2:42 onwards is only the result of Apostle Peter's sharing of the Gospel. As they faithfully proclaimed the gospel, those who heard turned their hearts and lives to Jesus.

Two things to highlight: the love of Christ and our love for others. The people

came together because of their loving relationship with Christ. As we experience the love of God in our lives, our greatest response of worship is only to love Him with gladness and thanksgiving! God's kind of love searches our hearts - creating the perfect space whereby we can love and accept others in return, for only the love of God can change our hearts so we can love others despite our


