SERMON OUTLINE

BURNING HEARTS

LUKE 24:32 I PASTOR NICOLO PADILLA

ur passage today talks about two disheartened disciples on a journey towards Emmaus. As they walked along, they were desperately trying to make sense of the events that took place. Everything appeared so promising, from the all miracles that He performed, to His teachings with power and authority. They were certain that Jesus was the long awaited Messiah.

But to their utter surprise and shock, this Man whom they placed their hope on, this Man who looked so promising, was publicly crucified for everyone to witness, their hopes shattered into pieces right before their eyes. These disciples experienced the pain of transitioning from being hopeful to hopeless, from being full of excitement to being deep in sorrow.

But although the narrative begins with two

seemingly disheartened disciples, this portion of Luke ended on a different note. Because of their personal encounter with the risen Messiah, their mourning turned into dancing, and their deep sadness turned into sheer joy.

To help us navigate through this portion of the Gospel of Luke, we will approach our text through two different lenses: (1) through the lens of the disciples and (2) through the lens of Jesus, the risen Messiah. I pray that at the end of our time in the Word, in the same way that these two disciples had hearts burning within them, each of us, too, will have hearts burning within us because of Jesus and for Jesus!"
