## BEHOLD THE WORK OF OUR UNSEEN GOD

EXODUS 2:1-25 I REV. LITO VILLORIA

Great is the work of our unseen God, though it's difficult to see His work when we are in a dilemma. The reality is He is actively at work. He is working things out to fulfill His purposes.

Pharaoh devised an evil plan to cast all newly born Hebrew sons into the Nile (Exodus 1:22). But his plan didn't prevail! Instead, God used it as an occasion to raise the deliverer of His people.

When Moses was born, he was not thrown into the Nile, but was gently placed along the riverbanks in a basket. Instead of experiencing the anger of Pharaoh, he was adopted by Pharaoh's own daughter who named him "Moses" for she said, "I drew him out of the water" (Exodus 2:1-10).

At forty years old, Moses killed an Egyptian for beating a Hebrew. The matter was made known and Pharaoh heard about it and sought to kill Moses. Moses left Egypt and fled to Midian for fear of his life (Exodus 2:11-15; Acts 7:23-24).

While in Midian, Moses found favor in the eyes of Reuel who gave Zipporah, one of

his daughters, to be Moses' wife. Moses was content in his life, even while in exile. He had a son and named him "Gershom" for he said, "I have been a sojourner in a foreign land" (Exodus 2:16-22).

The Pharaoh died, but the people of Israel continued to suffer. They groaned and cried out for help. God heard their pleas. He remembered His promise. He saw their predicament. God knew exactly the situation of His people and what He needed to do (Exodus 2:23-25).

Our unseen God is actively at work in our life. He hears you. He remembers you. He sees you. He knows you. Even before you cry out, God is already working out a way to help you in your predicament.

The challenge for us today is to learn how to behold the work of our unseen God! \*\*
