COME AND WORSHIP OUR HOLY GOD

EXODUS 5:1-21 I REV. LITO VILLORIA

Woses and Aaron were finally together to pursue God's call upon them. Aaron relayed all the words of the LORD to the people of Israel. Moses performed the two signs God told him to do. The people believed and worshipped God (Exodus 4:1-8, 29-31).

Exodus 5:1-21 emphasized the importance of God's people to worship Him in the wilderness. It highlights the need to worship God even amid difficult, dangerous, and depressing situations (Exodus 5:1, 3, 8, 17; cf. 3:18).

This passage records the initial confrontation between Moses and Aaron with Pharaoh. They relayed God's demand for Pharaoh to release the Israelites from slavery so they could worship Him in the wilderness. Pharaoh rejected God's demand (Exodus 5:1-5).

Pharaoh commanded the taskmasters and foremen to make the work of God's people more difficult. They were no longer to give the people raw materials to produce bricks. They were to let them gather it themselves. But, they had to come up with the same level of production (Exodus 4:6-9).

The Egyptian taskmasters implemented Pharaoh's command. They made life bitter for God's people. The foremen

of Israel suffered the full weight of Pharaoh's new directive. They were verbally and physically abused (Exodus 4:10-14).

The battered foremen of Israel went and appealed to Pharaoh for some respite. But, instead of receiving consideration, Pharaoh charged them for being lazy and asking permission to worship God as an excuse to avoid work (Exodus 4:15-18).

The foremen confronted Moses and Aaron. They accused them in anger for causing all their miseries and putting their life in danger. Moses again was rejected by his own people. Moses and Aaron must have been overwhelmed by their predicament that they could not offer any response (Exodus 4:19-21).

In this sermon, we will be challenged to worship God in whatever circumstances, no matter what the cost!
