## REMEMBER THE GREAT WORKS OF GOD

EXODUS 12:29-51 I REV. LITO VILLORIA

After the Israelites observed the Passover, God struck all the firstborn, both man and animal of every Egyptian household. A great cry filled the night over all of Egypt. Pharoah summoned Moses and Aaron. He asked them to urgently leave Egypt (Exodus 12:29-32).

The Egyptians were gripped with fear. They sent away the Israelites in haste. As the Israelites left, they plundered the Egyptians with no resistance to fulfill God's promise to Abraham (Exodus 12:33-36; Genesis 15:12-14).

After midnight, about 600,000 men, excluding women and children, together with other people groups went out of Egypt together with their livestock. The number of Israelites who came to Egypt numbered 70 (Genesis 46:26-27). Under Joseph, they increased greatly and grew exceedingly strong (Exodus 1:6-7). A new pharaoh who did not know Joseph rose to power. He oppressed the Israelites. But the more God's people were oppressed, the more they multiplied in number (Exodus 1:12, 20), (Exodus 12:37-39).

God's people lived in Egypt for 430 years. As the Israelites left Egypt during the Passover night, God watched over them all through the night. The Israelites commemorated this act by spending a night remembering God's great work in Egypt (Exodus 12:40-42).

God gave further instructions in the observance of Passover. The Passover was exclusive to the Israelites. But if any slave or foreigner would journey with God's people, they could take part in the Passover only after they got circumcised (Exodus 12:43-51).

The event during the dark Passover night was a milestone marker for Israel. It was where God displayed His great power. Often in the Scriptures, God's people are exhorted to go back and remember God's great work during the first Passover.

In seasons of darkness, it is wise to remember the great works of God to have confidence that He will see you through in the present.
