## PASSIT ON!

EXODUS 12:1-28 I REV. LITO VILLORIA

After God announced the final plague (Exodus 11:1-10), the writer slowed down the pace of the story to emphasize the Passover's significance.

The Passover marked the first calendar year for Israel. It was the first time Israel was referred to as one community. It was also the first time lambs without blemish were killed in relation to God's deliverance of His people. The blood of the lamb was put on the doorposts of every Israelite's home (Exodus 12:1-7, 21-22).

The Passover had to be observed at twilight. The lamb or goat had to be roasted whole—not boiled nor eaten raw. If there were any leftovers, they had to be burned. The Israelites had to be dressed up and ready to leave in haste while they ate (Exodus 12:8-11).

During the night of Passover, the LORD passed through all the land of Egypt and struck every firstborn, both man and beast. He executed judgment upon all the gods of Egypt. When the LORD saw blood on the door of a home, He passed over and spared that household from death (Exodus 12:12-13, 23).

The Passover and the Feast of Unleavened Bread are tied together. God's people ate

only unleavened bread for seven days. All leaven had to be removed from their homes. Anyone who ate unleavened bread had to be cut off from the community (Exodus 12:15-20).

The Passover had be observed as a memorial throughout all generations. The fathers were instructed to explain to their children who the LORD was and how He delivered His people out of Egypt. God's people responded in reverence and obedience (Exodus 12:14, 24-28).

The inauguration of the Passover commemorated God's great act of redemption for His people. The Passover foreshadows the sacrifice of Christ on the Cross. It is at the Cross that God redeemed man from sin. Therefore, if you are in Christ, God commissions you to pass on your faith to others!
