KNOW GOD AND MAKE HIM KNOWN

EXODUS 19:1-25 I REV. LITO VILLORIA

covenant God entered with Israel. After their slavery in Egypt (Exodus 1:1-15:22) and their journey in the wilderness (Exodus 15:23-18:27), Israel now stood before Mount Sinai, where God would descend from heaven to meet them.

Exodus 19 serves as a preamble to the constitution of Israel (Exodus 20:1 to 23:32). This chapter established Israel as a nation set apart to fulfill God's promise to Abraham that He would make him into a great nation. It also served as a catalyst to fulfill God's purpose of blessing all the nations through Abraham (Genesis 12:1-2; 18:17-18; 22:16-18; 26:1-5).

Knowing God is the greatest blessing that all the nations of the earth will receive through Israel. This was God's purpose in choosing Israel as His treasured possession, a kingdom of priests, and a holy nation. God displayed His glory and presence in Egypt (Exodus 6:7; 7:5, 17, 8:10, 22; 9:14, 29; 10:2; 11:7; 14:4, 18; 16:6, 12). God wants Himself to be known on all the earth through the nation Israel.

In this passage, there are four areas about God's work that we need to know: (1) God's promise [19:1-3a]; (2) God's purpose [19:3b-6]; (3) God's presence [19:7-9a, 16-20]; and (4) God's purity [19:9b-15, 21-25].

As we learn the implications of these four things about God, may the Holy Spirit convict us to make Him known to people around us in every season of our lives. As the Apostle Peter wrote:

"But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. 10 Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy." - 1 Peter 2:9-10
