onsider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, 3 because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. 4 Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and COMPLETE, not lacking anything. 5 If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you. James 1:2-5 NIV

In these turbulent times, many people's faiths (Christians included) have been put to a rigorous test, as we experience loss in many different forms that has left us devastated, uncertain, and, at times, left crying out to God that He would put a quick end to the current global crisis that has hit closer and closer to home.
