EXPERIENCE THE POWER OF GOD

Exodus 29:1-46 | REV. LITO VILLORIA

As the tabernacle's blueprint was given, God appointed Aaron and his sons to take charge of its operation. They are to preserve it as they journey towards the Promised Land. Since the tabernacle and its furnishings are holy, Aaron and his sons must be consecrated before they can fulfill their responsibilities.

Exodus 29 established the ordination of the priests. They must wear the prescribed attire as they offer sacrifices for themselves and on behalf of God's people. They are set apart for this ministry by the anointing of oil (Exodus 29:1-9).

Bulls and rams were to be dedicated to the Lord. The blood and inner parts of the bull were put on and burned on the altar, respectively. While the flesh and skin were burned outside the camp (Exodus 29:10-18).

Another ram was killed, the blood of which is put in the tips of the right ear of Aaron and his sons, and on the thumbs of their right hands and great toes of their right feet. Blood was also thrown against the altar and sprinkled on their garments. Other parts of the ram were burned or eaten (Exodus 29:19-34).

The ordination ceremony lasts for seven days. There was a daily sin offering for atonement. The altar must be purified with blood and anointed to consecrate it. Whatever touches the altar becomes holy (Exodus 29:35-37).

The priests served as mediators between God and Israel. They offer daily sacrifices as they worship God in the tent of meeting. At the appointed meeting place, God will dwell among His people, and they will know that He is the LORD their God (Exodus 29:38-46).

As temple of the living God, God has granted believers inherent divine power to live our life for Christ (1 Corinthians 3:16; 6:19; 2 Peter 1:3-4). In this sermon, we will learn how to experience God's power to fulfill His purposes and grace in our lives.✠
