

# MOBILIZERS WITH PSC SEND

JUN, DARLENE, ZAC & OLIVIA JOVELLANOS

**W**e are Jun & Darlene Jovellanos, with our kids Zac (17) and Olivia (16). We are mobilizers with PSC SEND (Philippine Sending Council of SEND International). We are thrilled that God is allowing us to be involved in mobilizing churches and individual believers to join God in reaching the nations of the world with the Gospel. As mobilizers, we are involved in several ministries:

## ACTESOL

We oversee a training program called Asia's Center for TESOL (Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages). We offer courses that equip believers to use English classes as a platform for ministry. Our certificate is designed specially for Christians who desire to use this training to connect with people/people groups that have not heard the gospel. Our main course offering is a 5-week intensive training that includes a 20-hour practicum, but we also offer less-intense programs on an as-needed basis. This year we adapted our program to an online format as we have not been able to conduct in-person classes since the start of the pandemic. We are hopeful that we can get back to in-person classes in 2022.

## KAIROS

We are also involved with Kairos, which you probably are already familiar with. We use this course to mobilize individuals, churches, PSC-SEND potential members, appointees, staff, and volunteers for involvement in reaching all

people groups of the world with the Gospel. This year, Jun led a course in March as the Head Facilitator on training and Darlene was a student participant. Darlene immediately proceeded to train as facilitator in June. Together we have helped facilitate two Kairos sessions since then and Darlene is currently involved in a third course. We are currently praying about the possibility of helping facilitate a face-to-face intensive 5-day course in November.

## ITSM

We also use AIM's mobilization training course (Introduction to Strategic Missions). We use this course more specifically in helping churches and individuals assess where they are in terms of missions and reaching the least reached peoples of the world with the Gospel. It defines what a Biblical church/christian should be in more of a practical sense. It helps assess whether an individual is a goer, sender, or intercessor. It also gives guidelines for adopting an unreached people group. Jun is a trained facilitator of ITSM.

## Malaysia Digital Engagement

Jun coordinates volunteer work for Filipinos to teach English online to refugees and migrant workers in Malaysia in partnership with El Shaddai ministries. We recruit volunteers here in the Philippines who have some teaching skills and have a heart for refugees and migrant workers in Malaysia and/or those who want to gain cross-cultural experience in preparation

for whatever ministries or people group that God is calling them to reach.

## Security Officer

Jun also serves as the Security Officer of PSC SEND. He is tasked to oversee all field security matters including training of members in general safety and field-specific issues, and conducting periodic risk assessments. His main task this year has been keeping up-to-date with the Covid-19 pandemic situation and its impact on PSC SEND members. Recently, he gathered a team to help him in this task and has begun to turn his attention to other security matters in cooperation with SEND leadership.

We praise God for the many opportunities He has been opening for us to be used for the glory of His Name and the building of His Kingdom. We are also thankful for the partnership with GCF South Metro in fulfilling His call in the mission field. ✨
