## THE MISSION'S STILL THE SAME

MATTHEW 28:18-20 I REV. MIKE TRINIDAD

Today, we have a sermon series break as we celebrate the last Sunday of Missions Month. It has truly been a wonderful way to be reminded of what has been doing in our midst as we obey the Great Commission, as a church, and hopefully in our individual capacities, as the Great Commission is for every Christian to obey. As renowned and esteemed English Protestant Missionary, James Hudson Taylor, said,

"The Great Commission is not an option to be considered; it is a command to be obeyed." Indeed, careful scrutiny of our GC passage tells us that although it was primarily given to the first disciples, it has been passed on to us, literally and figuratively, after we confess our sins and profess faith in Jesus Christ, the Risen Savior!

"And Jesus came and said to them, All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. <sup>19</sup>Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. <sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe all that I have commanded

you. And behold, I am with you always to the end of the age." Matthew 28:18-20

The main call for all followers is to make disciples. But, as we do so, we are called to do three things - Go, Baptize and Teach. As some have been called to go out into the mission field, it means actually leaving their comfort zones to minister in specific places to different people groups. Filipinos in the diaspora are in a unique position to fulfill the command contained in the Great Commission. But, for many of us, our mission field could be right where we are, in our homes, our communities, workplaces or places of study.

Jesus Christ, the resurrected Lord Himself gave the Great Commission for us to obey. That is what I would like to highlight today - the significance of the risen Christ as integral to the Great Commission so that people would obtain hope in their present struggles in life.
