## GIVE BACK TO GOD GENEROUSLY AND FREELY

EXODUS 35:1-29 I REV. LITO VILLORIA

In the covenant renewal, the construction of God's tabernacle began (Exodus 35-40). These last chapters of the Book of Exodus highlight God's mercies upon His people and Moses' faithfulness to God.

Prior to the construction of the tabernacle, Moses assembled the entire congregation of Israel and emphasized the importance of Sabbath. He emphasized that man must work diligently for six days and rest on the seventh day as an act of worship. Sabbath is a reminder that God is in control of all things, God provides for everything, and God created man to rest as He works for Him (Exodus 35:1-3).

God gave the congregation of Israel—all the men, women, and leaders—the divine privilege to contribute to the building of God's dwelling place among them. He commanded them to give generously from their hearts. They were to lavishly give back to God what God had graciously given unto them. They were mere stewards of what God had entrusted to them. God also commanded

every skillful craftsman to use their gifts in the tabernacle's construction (Exodus 35:4-19).

When the congregation departed from Moses' presence, they gathered what they had as their hearts were stirred. And everyone whose hearts were stirred brought their contributions and gave willingly and freely to the Lord (Exodus 35:20-29).

As God gave the Israelites the opportunity to contribute to the building of His tabernacle, He also gives us the divine privilege to take part in His kingdom building work. It is through the church that God reveals His eternal purpose in Christ Jesus (Ephesians 3:10). As recipients of spiritual blessings, we must give back to God generously and freely through the local church we consider our spiritual family (Romans 15:27; 2 Corinthians 8:1-7; 9:7-8).
