PAY CAREFUL ATTENTION TO GOD'S WORD

EXODUS 35:30-39:43

After the people gave their contributions to the LORD, Moses declared God had already hand picked the right people who would build His tabernacle. God personally and specifically called Bezalel to lead the construction of His dwelling place. He filled him with the Spirit and gave him the necessary skills to fulfill His divine task. And He directed Bezalel to teach others who would work under him (Exodus 35:30-34).

God also filled Oholiab and every craftsman with the necessary skills and knowledge to do their specific assignments. God gave them abilities to do their work according to all that He had commanded (Exodus 35:35-36:1).

When the construction started, the people kept bringing their freewill offerings daily. All the craftsmen received more than what they needed to do the work of the Lord. Moses had to restrain the people from giving because the materials they received were more than sufficient for what was required (Exodus 36:2-7).

Bezalel led Oholiab and every craftsman in making everything needed to complete the tabernacle and its furnishings. They worked on every detail

diligently and skillfully. In the end, they made everything exactly as the LORD had commanded (39:1, 5, 7, 21, 26, 29, 31-32, 42-43) (Exodus 36:8-39:43).

God gave precise and detailed instructions on building His sanctuary. The repercussions for even a slight deviation could have been precarious (2 Samuel 6:6). But when God gives a command, He provides everything needed to do His will. There is no excuse for Moses and Bezalel not to do what God wants to do. All they needed to do was to pay attention to God's commands.

In this sermon, we will learn that God directs our lives with His Word. God reveals in His Word what we need to know to do His will. And when He commands us to do something, He provides everything we need to obey Him. Therefore, there is no excuse for us not to do what God wants to do. We just need to pay attention to His Word! **
