JESUS OUR RESURRED KING

In our sermon today, we will focus on the kingship of our Resurrected Lord and its impact in our lives today.

The New Testament describes Jesus Christ as the Davidic King and the fulfillment of Old Testament prophecies about the Promised Messiah. It began with the infancy narratives in the Gospels, asserting Jesus Christ as the "son of David" whose kingdom would have no end (Matthew 1:1; Luke 1:32-33). It ended with Jesus Himself declaring He is the "root and the descendant of David, the bright morning star" (Revelation 22:16).

Though Jesus Christ is God, who pre-existed with the Father, and perceived by men as king during His time on earth (John 1:1-2, 49-51; 18:36), His kingship was inaugurated during His resurrection. The first Resurrection Sunday was like a coronation event when a monarch was crowned to symbolize regal authority. It was at this moment when Jesus Christ sat upon His throne in heaven and exercised His authority over all the earth

(Ephesians 1:19-21; Acts 2:30-33).

Unlike earthly kings and human authorities, the reign of Christ is universal, eternal, mighty, and righteous (Zechariah 9:10; 2 Samuel 7:16; Psalm 110:1-2; Jeremiah 23:5-6). The current presence of evil and wickedness is in no way a weakness of Christ's power. But it reflects His strong compassion for people to repent and turn to Him (Hebrews 9:27-28).

One day, our Resurrected King will return and establish His kingdom here on earth. He will defeat all His enemies swiftly, once and for all. He will prove Himself as "Faithful and True," "The Word of God," and "King of kings and Lord of lords" who alone is worthy to be worshiped by all (Revelation 19:11-16).

Jesus, our Resurrected King, will disappoint no one who puts their trust in Him!
