TRUE WORSHIP

God's promises of His presence, protection and provision are repeated throughout the Bible. Jacob received these promises from the Lord when he was in search of his place in life. In response to God's promises, Jacob learned what it is to worship God, in the truest sense. Believers are recipients of God's unfailing words of assurances. Our response then to God's promises of presence, protection, and provision should be that of true worship. But what is true worship?

I. True Worship is living in the fear of the Lord (vv. 16-17).


When Jacob awoke from his sleep, he thought, "Surely the LORD is in this place, and I was not aware of it." He was afraid and said, "How awesome is this place! This is none other than the house of God; this is the gate of heaven."

II. True worship is living for the glory of God (vv. 18-19).

Early the next morning Jacob took the stone he had placed under his head and set it up as a pillar and poured oil on top of it. 19 He called that place Bethel, though the city used to be called Luz.

III. True worship is living in submission to God (vv. 20-22).

Then Jacob made a vow, saying, "If God will be with me and will watch over me on this journey I am taking and will give me food to eat and clothes to wear so that I return safely to my father's house, then the Lord will be my God and this stone that I have set up as a pillar will be God's house, and of all that you give me I will give you a tenth." ✠
