POST-ELECTION POSTURE: ENCOURAGE ONE ANOTHER

REV. LITO VILLORIA | ROMANS 1:1-15

Almost a week has passed since the most emotionally charged election we ever had as a nation. During this crucial political transition period, we need to have the right posture in our hearts to keep track of the way God wants us to go. In this first sermon of our series, "The Power of the Gospel," we will be exhorted to encourage one another. In his salutation, Paul revealed his identity, message and mission. He was a servant and apostle of Christ. The message he proclaimed was the gospel of God concerning the Promised Messiah of the Old Testament. His mission was for people to live a life of obedience anchored on their faith in Jesus Christ (1:1-6).

Paul addressed believers in Rome who were loved by God and called to be set apart for Him. He blessed them with the grace and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ (1:7).

Paul thanked God because the faith of the believers was known throughout the world. He asserted God knew how he constantly prayed for them; he also expressed his desire to visit them as God willed (1:8-10).

At the end of this section,

Paul expressed two reasons why he wanted to visit the Roman believers. First, for him and the believers to be mutually encouraged as he imparts to them spiritual gifts so they could be strengthened in their faith. And second, for him to witness the fruit of his labor among them as he did with other Gentiles. Since he received the gospel of God by grace, he was passionate about passing it on to others like a debt to be repaid (Romans 1:11-15).

As Paul desired to encourage the believers, I will impart practical applications on how we can mutually encourage one another to strengthen our faith in Christ during this highly charged post-election season. ✱
