HONOR THE COMMANDMENTS OF GOD

law but if they do not follow it, it is useless. Instead of them being a light to the world, they instead bring darkness because of their dishonor of God (vv.17-23).

Rirst section of the Letter to the Romans of man's condemnation. In this chapter, Paul talks first about how self-righteous people come under judgment (v1). We learn that this coming judgment is sure and certain (v.3), and that the mercies of God should not make us think we will escape judgment but rather, it should lead us to repentance (v.4).

Paul then talks about circumcision as one of the privileges given to Jews as God's chosen people. But they have taken circumcision as a sign of salvation more than their obedience to the law. Paul reminds them that being a Jew is not about having the law or being circumcised, but it is a matter of circumcision of the heart by the spirit (vv.25-29).


We see how God judges every one impartially according to his work (vv.6,11) and, depending on what each person does, that is how he will be judged (vv.9-10).

So, let us honor the commandments of the Lord so that we do not dishonor Him by our self-righteousness and so that we may instead rely on nothing else except the saving mercies of God through Christ Jesus.

It doesn't depend on our knowledge of the law. Paul explains that it is not those who hear the law who are righteous, rather, it is those who obey the law (v.13). For the Gentiles who do not know the law, they are also without excuse, because it is their conscience that will bear witness for them (v.15). When judgment day comes, everything that we have done, including things we think are hidden will come to light, because it is Jesus Christ who will judge, and nothing that is hidden will remain hidden (v.16).



Paul reminds Jewish believers that the privileges they have as God's chosen people will not save them. They have the
