## BREAKFREE!

REV. MIKE TRINIDAD I ROMANS 3:21-31

In our current series, "The Power of the Gospel" from Paul's Letter to the Romans, Pastor Lito presented us with the five (5) major divisions of the Book of Romans: 1) The Problem of Man - Condemnation; 2) The Provision from God - Justification; 3) The Progression from God - Sanctification; 4) The Plan for Israel - Vindication; and 5) The Prescription for Man - Application.

From Romans 1:18 -3:20, we have taken up the first major division on The Problem of Man - condemnation. Indeed, by man's sinfulness, we are separated from God, condemned and deserve punishment for our sins.

Beginning today, we will look at the second major division, which is The Provision from God - **JUSTIFICATION**. From the shackles of sin that bind us, we find hope in God's provision that is made available to all those who believe and put their faith and trust in Jesus as they receive Him as personal Lord and Savior.


Paul started off by using an important transition - "BUT NOW". It is important for us to understand why Paul used it because it lays the foundation for what message he wants us to glean from our

text - the righteousness of God is received by grace through faith in Jesus Christ.

Careful perusal of the preceding verses reveal Paul's admonition to the Romans against blind obedience to the Law. He states in v.20 that no one can ever be made right with God merely by doing what the Law commands. Paul, however, is not against the law, per se, but the wrong perspective of the Jews about the Law and their belief that obedience to the Law is a means for salvation.

Let us draw strength in knowing that because of God's great love for us, He has given the provision for us to be set free from our sins, and that is through faith in His only Begotten Son, Jesus Christ!
