MORE THAN CONQUERORS IN CHRIST

REV. BOBOT ANDALIS | ROMANS 8:31-39

This section of the book of Romans 8:31-39 is the last part of the third Major Part-Progression of Man: Sanctification.

Here, the Apostle Paul talks about the most crucial part of the sanctification process of believers, "the love of God through Christ." After giving several hypothetical questions in verses 31-36, the Apostle Paul gives his answer in verse 37 which says, "37 No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us", and assured them of the truth that nothing can separate the Roman believers from the love of Christ (vv. 38-39).

For this sermon, I pray that may we all be challenged and assured that in whatever situation in life we experience, nothing can separate us from the love of Christ because we are more than conquerors through Him (vv. 35-37). This truth is very important for all of us today for it gives us four (4) reasons, to be assured of the love of God. *God is our* safeguard (vs. 31-32). No one will go against us because of Christ. God is our advocate (vv. 33-34). Nothing can condemn us because of Christ's death and resurrection. God is our deliverer (vv. 35-36). Nothing can move us. God is our sustainer (vv. 37-39). Nothing can separate us from the love of Christ. Verse 38 says, "For am sure...", it will firm our faith in Christ because it gives us the certainty of God's love for us.

With the daily situations we experience in life, we are not exempt from any form of trial. You need to train yourself to do it. How will you train yourself to be more than conquerors in Christ? There are four (4) ways to train yourself to be more than conquerors in Christ.

Seek wisdom from God (vv. 31-32). Whenever you face trials of any kind, always go back to God and His word to ask for wisdom on what He would do in your situation (Jas. 1:5). Seek strength from God (vv. 35-36). Life problems overwhelm you that make you physically and emotionally drained (Ps. 51:7-9; Philippians 4:13). Rest in the unconditional love of God (vv. 34-35; Matthew 11:28-30). God's unconditional love secures you of His abiding presence. *Relinquish* everything that hinders you from experiencing God's peace in your life (vv. 37, 39). The Lord is your sure refuge in the midst of whatever seasons in life you are in (Ps. 46).

Indeed, we are more than conquerors in Christ Jesus because of His finished works on the cross and His resurrection that gave us the power to overcome sins and challenges in life. We should always be assured that whatever season in life we may be in, nothing can separate you and me from the love of Christ. God bless us all! #
