# AKING WORTHY TO BE ADORED

REV. LITO VILLORIA I ISAIAH 9:6-7

In God's appointed time, He sent forth His Son, Jesus Christ, born of a virgin, to provide redemption and forgiveness of sins. He is the Promised Messiah prophesied to deliver the nation of Israel from distress and darkness.

However, during the First Advent, Jesus Christ was rejected by His own people. The Jewish people were waiting for a ruling, reigning, and conquering king, not a Suffering Servant and a Humiliated King. He suffered on the way to Calvary. He was humiliated at the Cross.

After Jesus Christ died, He was buried. But on the third day He resurrected from the grave. After spending 40 days with His disciples, He ascended into heaven and sat at the right hand of the Father. Then one day in human history, at the Second Advent, He will come down from heaven and return bodily on earth to reign in His millennial kingdom. From today until the Second Advent, we will not be spared from problems, pressures, and predicaments. But knowing

who Jesus Christ is and adoring Him for who He is should influence our outlook in life.

In Isaiah 9:6-7, we will learn seven (7) attributes of Jesus Christ that should move us to adore Him as our Righteous King.

First, Jesus Christ is fully-man and fully-God (Isaiah 9:6a).

Second, Jesus Christ is the Ruler of all nations (Isaiah 9:6b).

Third, Jesus Christ is our Wonderful Counselor (Isaiah 9:6c).

Fourth, Jesus Christ is our Mighty God (Isaiah 9: 6c).

Fifth, Jesus Christ is our Everlasting Father (Isaiah 9: 6c).

Sixth, Jesus Christ is our Prince of Peace (Isaiah 9: 6c).

And seventh, Jesus Christ is the Eternal Davidic King (Isaiah 9:7).

This Christmas we will be challenged to adore Jesus Christ, our Righteous King, by living a life fully surrendered to Him. #
