RECOMMIT YOURSELF TO GOD

REV. DON GUICO | DEUTERONOMY 10:12-13

It is a new year. And just like any new year, we again set goals for ourselves – not new, but usually rehashed from the past year because we somehow failed to accomplish them. That is why we love the turning of the calendar, it gives us the HOPE of a fresh start.

In our passage today, the Israelites were about to start a new chapter in their lives as a nation. When they were about to enter the land God promised to give them, Moses recounted to them their journey – the many times the LORD manifested His power, provisions and presence, and the many times they quickly turned away from the Lord, rebelling against His commandments, and not believing Him or obeying His voice (Deuteronomy 1 to 9). This was not to lecture them of their failures due to their own stubbornness, but to encourage them to always look upon the LORD – who He is and what He has done for them – so that they might not only be emboldened by the assurance that the LORD their God is with them, but that they might also become the people who would truly honor and glorify Him.

In Deuteronomy 10:12-13, Moses instructed the Israelites what He requires of them in the form of a question. They were to:

- 1) **Fear the LORD their God** – being in awe and submitting to Him
- 2) **Walk in all His ways** – conducting their lives in accordance with the will of God
- 3) **Love Him** – choosing to set their affections on the Lord and on Him alone
- 4) **Serve the LORD their God**

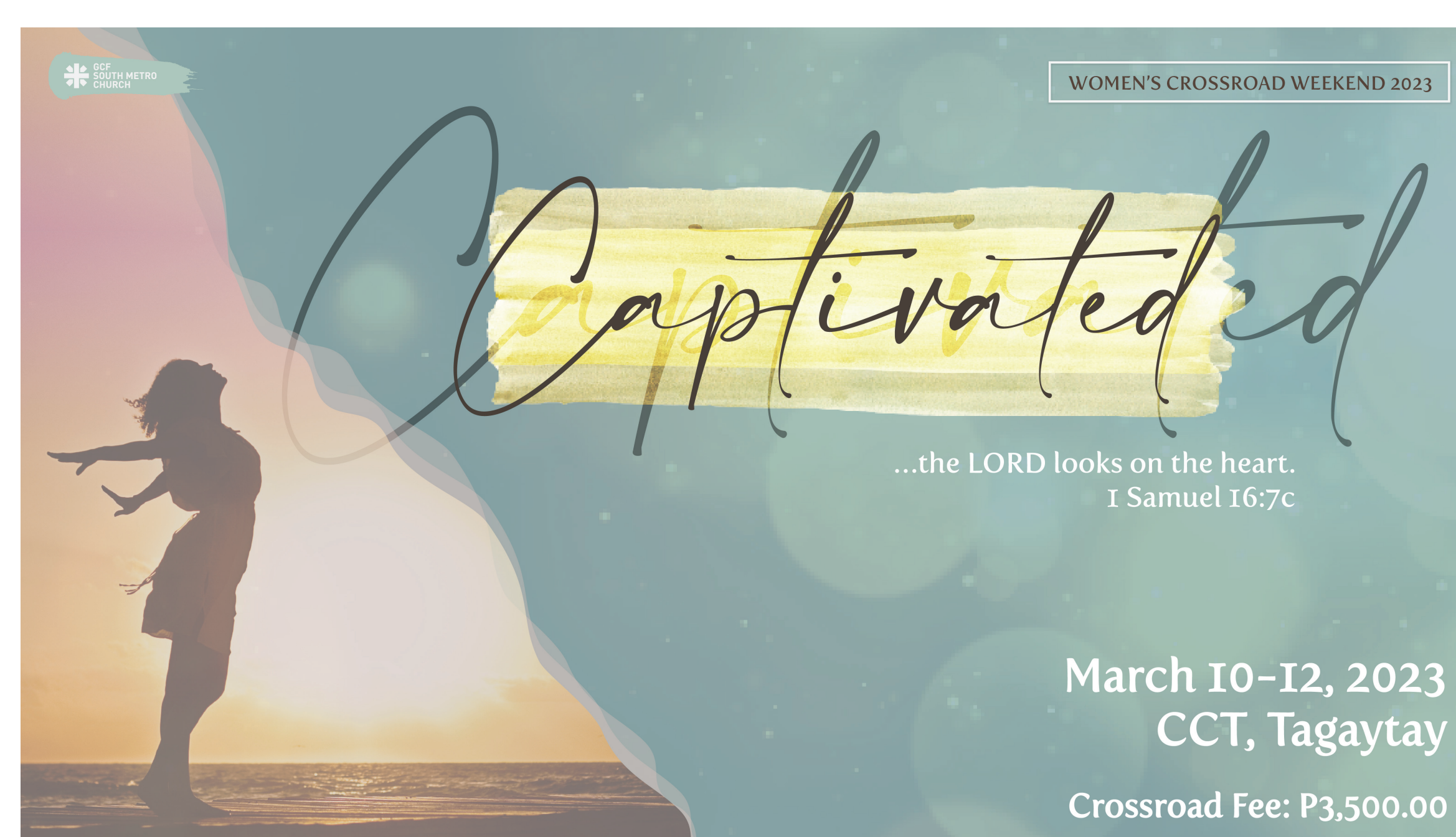
with all their heart and with all their soul – making the Lord the center of everything they do
5) **Keep the commandments and the statutes of the LORD** – obeying the requirements the Lord had imposed

And as God's people today, we are to do the same, especially since we have Jesus who intercedes for us, the Word of God to light our way, and the Holy Spirit who empowers us to fulfill God's requirements.

We may, to some degree, have failed in our relationship with God in the past, but He is giving us a fresh start today. He is calling us to recommit ourselves to Him. So here are four things that we must practice:

- 1) **Daily consecration**
- 2) **Daily confession**
- 3) **Daily communication**
- 4) **Daily commitment**

By the grace and mercy of God, may we all be able to fulfill our goal of becoming better disciples this year! ✠
