WORSHIP THROUGH OBEDIENCE

What a beautiful sight it is to see God's people come and meet to worship Him. As we worship, we remember who God is and the things that He has done in our lives.

Holy Week is just around the corner, a time given for us to commemorate how our Lord Jesus Christ sacrificed His own life as a payment for our sins. We are blessed to be recipients of the greatest act of love this world has ever seen. How the one and only Son of God willingly went through one of the most painful and humiliating punishments ever. How do we respond to such love?

In Psalm 81, we are shown how to worship God joyfully with all our heart, body, and soul. We worship because we are grateful. When we realize how God has delivered us several times in the past from different kinds of problems, we get a glimpse of just how awesome His love for us truly is. Sadly, just like the Israelites, we easily forget and resort back to our stubborn ways instead of being obedient to God.
