RESURRECTION SUNDAY

This Sunday, we celebrate the miraculous work of God through Jesus Christ! Today is a day to celebrate because we are reminded of the anchor of our faith that has been resurrected. We are victorious because Jesus is alive! I remember when I was growing up how every Holy Week, my family would travel to Bicol to visit our relatives. Whenever l was there as a child, I got to watch the tradition of "Penitensiya". People would walk around town hitting their own backs with bamboo shards or sometimes even broken glass to reenact how Jesus was punished on the way to the cross. I always wondered why people would do it willingly. I asked my uncle back then, and he said they do it to help them to not forget the sacrifice of Jesus and to try and pay for their wrongdoings.
