GOD OUR MAKER AND MASTER

PASTOR PARKIN YOUNG | PSALM 100

This psalm is a psalm that is short but it is full of truths that we are to embody today as believers. And if we are not yet believers, we can also see in this psalm glimpses of God's person, power, and presence.

Psalm 100 starts off with verse 1 and 2 on how we are to make a joyful noise to the Lord, serve the Lord with gladness, and come into His presence with singing. All these denotes how we are to praise God joyfully! When we come into His presence, there should be joy in our hearts because we are in the presence of the most High God! One thing to note here is that the command is given to all people; not just the Israelites.

Verse 3 then talks about how we are to know God for two major things. First, that He is our creator. He made us, and because He made us, we are His people! The second thing is that because He is our creator, we are likened to being like sheep in the pasture of the Master Shepherd.

Verse 4 repeats this command to be joyful and thankful to God. We are told to enter His gates and courts with thanksgiving. This refers to the tabernacle of God and how everyone is to come into God's tabernacle with praise and thanksgiving in our hearts. And in verse 5 we find the reason why we are to be thankful and praising God. It is because the Lord is good! His steadfast love endures forever! And His faithfulness

is everlasting! But where do we see these characteristics? Well we need to go back to verse 3, because it is found in the middle of this psalm. When we want to see God's goodness, we need to remember that He made us!

And because He made us, He made the way for us to be with Him despite our sins. He made a way through Christ on the cross. That is His steadfast love! And when we want to see His faithfulness, we need to remember that we are God's sheep and He is our Master. Because He is our Master, we know He is faithful.

So we need to come into God's presence, know God's person, and praise God's power. When we do this we are able to praise God for He is our Maker and our Master. That is how we can find true rest in all the things we are going through today. Blessed Sunday everyone! ✱
