THE GOD OF VENGEANCE

REV. LITO VILLORIA | PSALM 94

Psalm 94 is a prayer for God to vindicate the righteous being oppressed by evildoers. The psalmist asked for divine retribution to be upon the wicked. When these people thought they could get away with whatever they wanted, the psalmist expressed confidence that in the end, God would wipe out all wickedness.

The psalmist appealed to God, the God of vengeance, the Judge of the earth, to repay the proud, arrogant, and abusive. He called on God to gloriously display His judgment in all the earth. However, he lamented on how long the weak and needy would be oppressed. These evildoers thought no one would make them accountable for their wicked actions (Psalm 94:1-7).

The psalmist affirmed that God knows everything and warns the arrogant to forsake their foolishness. God, who hears and sees, will rebuke and discipline those who disobey His instructions. He is fully aware of the thoughts of man and nothing escapes His sight (Psalm 94:8-11).

The psalmist asserted that God blesses those who submit to His discipline and teachings. He will grant them

rest from all their troubles until the wicked are destroyed. He will not abandon His people but will surely vindicate them (Psalm 94:12-15).

The psalmist assured that God will deliver His people and impose divine retribution to the wicked. God will stand up to help those who call upon Him. He will preserve, protect, and care for His people. The wicked have no place in God's kingdom and will be wiped out in the end. But, the righteous will experience victory in God who is their stronghold and rock of refuge (Psalm 94:16-23).

God is a God of vengeance who will not let evildoers and wickedness go unpunished. Although sometimes, He allows them to linger, eventually He will destroy all of them in the time of judgment. In this sermon, we will learn how we should respond when we see, or even experience for ourselves, evil, injustice, corruption, and wickedness. ✱
