THE LORD WHO PRESERVES

REV. MARK MAGANGAT | PSALM 31

Psalm 31 reveals the heart of David as he pours out his plea for deliverance and takes refuge in the Lord's preserving power. In the face of adversity, David's unwavering trust in God's righteousness and faithfulness resounds. This psalm beautifully portrays the Lord as the ultimate preserver of His people.

Here, we find David pouring out his heart to God, earnestly seeking His deliverance and protection. With a humble plea, David appeals to the Lord for help and refuge in his time of need. David's words express his unwavering trust in God's righteousness and faithfulness (31:1-2).

David expresses his unwavering trust in God's faithfulness. He finds strength in the Lord, likening Him to a rock and fortress. David seeks God's guidance and deliverance, acknowledging his dependency on the Almighty and surrendering his life into His hands (31:3-8).

This psalm also reveals David's deep distress, isolation, and enemies plotting against him. He cries out to God for mercy, describing his sorrow and physical and emotional exhaustion. Despite the challenges, David seeks God's intervention, finds comfort in His grace and preserving

power (31:9-13), and continues to declare his unwavering trust in God's deliverance and protection. He relies on God's mercy and faithfulness, seeking His presence and favor. David expresses his need for God's intervention, acknowledging that God's steadfast love will preserve his life (31:14-18).

Considering all the things he experienced, David declares his firm belief in God's goodness and sovereignty. He acknowledges God's abundant goodness stored for the faithful and His protective presence against human schemes. David encourages others to love and trust in the Lord, emphasizing His preserving power and just response (31:19-22).

In the end, David pleads for God's favor and proclaims confidence in Him. He urges all the saints to love and trust the Lord, highlighting His preservation of the faithful and just judgment on the proud. David encourages strength and courage for those who wait on the Lord (31:23-24).

In this sermon, we will be exhorted to trust in God's sovereignty and find refuge in Him, knowing that He is our secure stronghold. ✠
