# GOD'S INCOMPARABLE GLORY

REV. MIKE TRINIDAD I PSALM 113

Scripture remind us continually, we have the assurance of God's mighty, awesome and supreme power that is available to God's faithful followers - His servants.

Truly, our great, mighty and awesome God is worthy of all praise and His glory is incomparable, indeed! Absolutely no one or nothing compares to His glorious majesty as He rightfully sits on His throne! And, that is what the unknown writer of Psalm 113 reminds God's people to do - to praise the Lord forever and ever! The writer begins and ends this psalm with the command - PRAISE THE LORD, or "Hal lu-yah" in Hebrew, from where we derive the present usage, "Hallelujah"! Similarly, the succeeding psalms 115-117 end with the same command to praise the Lord! Likewise worthy of mention is that the command is written 23 times in the Book of Psalms.

As God sits enthroned in His rightful place, we behold His incomparable being and person as He gives hope to two special groups of people that we find in

vv. 6-9, the poor and the childless. These two groups are marginalized and looked down upon and have been relegated to the dumps and to remote places by society who shun them and give them no hope in life. But, in the eyes of God, the poor and the barren are given their rightful place, resting in the bosom of the Father.

Indeed, in all things, at all times, in all circumstances, let us heed the exhortation of the unknown writer to praise the Lord, to erupt in thanksgiving for who He is as we recognize Him as our mighty God who is above all things. Thankfully, this includes the most painful, impossible and difficult circumstances we could ever imagine for ourselves and even to the people that God brings to our lives.

And that should encourage us to never falter to point people to God whose glory is truly incomparable and the one who is able to bring light to the darkest moments we could ever find ourselves in!

Let everything that has breath, therefore, PRAISE THE LORD! \*\*
