OUR EVERLASTING GOD

REV. DON GUICO | PSALM 90

Moses, the man chosen by God to deliver His people from slavery in Egypt and lead them to the land He promised, opens Psalm 90 acknowledging who God is - "... from everlasting to everlasting you are God" (v. 2).

Moses recognized that God had constantly been Israel's and her forebears' dwelling place. *In* God, they had constantly experienced His protection from enemies and other dangers, received provision for all their physical needs, and had stability in the midst of inner turmoil and surrounding threats. *In* God is rest.

Moses also made a stark contrast between the eternity of God and temporality of man, describing man's existence as very fleeting. And being finite, man is also limited in power and strength. But what is tragic with man is not his finiteness, it is how foolishly he spends his days, and thus, the futility of his life.

Despite God being faithful to Israel, they have displayed their propensity for unrighteousness and unfaithfulness toward Him on many occasions. They did not put their trust in God

despite the great wonders He had performed. They remained stubborn, they grumbled, and they rebelled against Him. Because of Israel's iniquities and secret sins, God's anger was upon them (vv. 7-9). They did not consider the power of God's anger and had no fear of the Lord (v. 11).

As God's people today, we are no better than the Israelites. Which is why we must also plead to God as Moses did in verse 12. In this life that is full of toil and trouble, we must number our days by asking God for His...

- wisdom, that we may live for Him and for others.
- mercy, that we may be in right standing before Him.
- love, that we may be content and rejoice in Him always.
- gladness, that we may persevere amidst trials.
- power, that we may overcome and stand victorious.
- favor, that we may truly glorify Him.

Our God is everlasting, even in His all His ways. But as finite beings, we must do what will really matter in life, will have eternal impact, will reap an eternal reward for us, and will bring honor and glory to our everlasting God! ✨
