GOD THE MIGHTY ONE

REV. VINCE SYYAP I PSALM 50

Being a part of a church community such as GCF South Metro, we are exposed to a loving church family together with our fellow believers. We welcome the warm smiles, tight hugs, cheerful greetings that make us feel so at home. This kind of warmth reflects the love of Jesus Christ. This is why we are so familiar with a loving, gracious, patient, and meek God. He is all that to His children.

But just like the Israelites, there are those who take this love for granted, and this is evidenced by a lack of authenticity. They claim to be children of the Almighty but live lives that are contradictory to His Word.

In this psalm, Asaph shows us that God will not tolerate this kind of lifestyle. Just as the way God judged the Israelites for their mistakes, we will one day be held accountable for all our actions before God.

When we first started our walk with Christ, we knew Him to be a loving Savior who offered us forgiveness and eternal life. But this time, we know that we will

face the Holiness of God, a judge who will expect us to live by His precepts and standards.

In 1 Peter 4:17, it says, "For it is time for judgment to begin at the household of God; and if it begins with us, what will be the outcome for those who do not obey the gospel of God?" We should not take our journey with God for granted because God will hold us accountable. We go to church regularly, we give our tithes and offerings, we join the missions efforts of the church, we sing in praise and worship, we attend growth group meetings, we read the Bible and pray. We should have nothing to worry about, right? But what is God really looking for in us?

Perhaps a good way to answer this question is with another question. As you sit here in our worship hall today, or as you watch the Worship Service online, answer this as honestly as you can - What is in your heart today?

As you ponder this question, focus on God and honor the Mighty One! #
