SERMON OUTLINE

THE LORD'S ANOINTED REIGNS

REV. LITO VILLORIA | PSALM 2

Psalm 2 is one of the eleven (11) royal psalms (18, 20-21, 45, 72, 89, 101, 110, 132, 144). A royal psalm celebrates the coronation of Jesus Christ, the Promised Messiah, as the King who will reign for eternity! In this psalm, David exhorted all nations to surrender to the LORD's Anointed and submit to His authority. He warns rebellious nations about the wrath of Christ who will rule with a rod of iron.

David wondered why nations could be so deluded about their God-given authorities. The platform they used deceived them into thinking they had complete power over everything. They denounced God's authority and even planned to overthrow Him. David could not fathom why these nations would dare stand against the LORD's anointed (2:1-3).

David described God's response to the rebellious nations. He simply laughed at those who thought they were powerful when in reality they were powerless. He sits enthroned in the heavens as the Righteous Judge. When God finally establishes the reign of Christ in Jerusalem upon His Second Coming, He will end all the rebellion of all the nations on earth (2:4-6).

David declared God's decree for His One and Only Begotten Son to be the Eternal King. Every

nation will be subjected to Him as His own possession. Christ, the Promised Messiah will break into pieces with a rod of iron every rebellious nation. They will be broken like a jar made of clay without any hope of restoration (2:7-9).

David exhorted all human authorities to be wise in subjecting themselves to Christ's authority. They must serve Him with fear and worship Him in humility. They must surrender everything to Him otherwise they will experience His wrath. In the end, David affirmed it is only in Christ that one can take refuge and be spared from God's wrath.

In this sermon, we will learn that Jesus Christ, the LORD's Anointed, will return one day to reign as the Eternal King. There will be no second chances after death and at the Second Coming! He will judge the rebellious and save those who are in Him. Therefore, in whatever season of life we are in, there is an urgent call for us to take part in the Great Commission!

Let us show and share the love and gospel of Christ to everyone at every opportunity before it is too late! ✠
