THE GREAT WORKS OF GOD

REV. DONG VILLATITO | PSALM 92

The superscription of this psalm indicates that this psalm was written primarily for the Sabbath and should be sung on the Sabbath Day. The authorship was not clearly stated but what was highlighted was God's character and works, His favor for the righteous, and dealings with the wicked.

This psalm can be divided into two sections: (1) God and His dealings with the righteous and; (2) God and His dealings with the wicked. The psalmist elaborated on what the righteous should do in relation to God's character and works. They are to thank and praise God as they acknowledge who He is - the one "Most High" (vv. 1-3).

The psalmist further stressed the time the righteous should thank and praise God. It should be at all times, remembering God's unfailing love in the morning and faithfulness in the night, providing an image for the reader of two (2) essential elements of a full day (morning and night). For the Jewish people, a day begins at nightfall and ends at nightfall of the following day (v .2).

Night and day also provide the reader with an image of the seasons the people of God

go through. There are days of rejoicing and celebration, and there are nights of grief and testing. In both seasons, the believer must maintain a heart that is thankful and full of praise for God's loving kindness and faithfulness (v .2).

The psalmist went on to describe how the righteous should thank and praise God through singing and with stringed instruments. Such gives an image of a loud voice and instruments intended to be heard as it provides the reader an image of the significance of proclaiming God's glorious character and works (v .3). For the church today, the challenge is to proclaim the gospel as the greatest work of God and expression of His greatest character, loving-kindness, and faithfulness.

The psalmist concluded by asserting that the righteous should thank and praise God because of His person (vv. 4-5) and because of His provision (vv. 10-15). As we reflect on this message, may we be encouraged to go back to the glorious truth that God is worthy of our praise and thanksgiving always and in every season! ✱
