SERMON OUTLINE

THE LORD **WORTHY OF OUR TRUST**

REV. LITO VILLORIA I PSALM 125

his psalm is part of the Song of Ascents. It is considered a communal psalm. It exhorts God's people that in times of evil dominion, they can put their confidence in the Lord who is worthy of trust. They can trust the Lord for who He is, what He can do and where He is.

The psalmist asserts that God provides stability and security to those who trust in Him. They are compared to Mount Zion where Jerusalem sits. Mount Zion was used here to portray an image of

someone standing on a strong foundation. Jerusalem, being surrounded by mountains, is a metaphor for security. The Lord who is powerful and eternal is worthy of trust (125:1-2).

The psalmist assures that God provides a way out for His people in times of difficulty. When evil seems to prevail, God's people can trust the Lord will keep them stable and secure. They can have confidence because God will not allow them to be tested beyond what they can endure. The "scepter of wickedness" represents prevailing evil and wickedness. The Lord protects and preserves His people in the midst of evil domination (125:3).

The psalmist appeals for God to bless those who strive to be right with Him. The ones who trust in God will be convicted to do good for they will have confidence in His abiding presence. On the contrary,

those who go their own way will be led astray by evil and suffer the consequences of their disobedience. The Lord provides blessings and peace to those who put their trust in Him (125:4-5).

As we live in the end times, do not be surprised when you see that evil and wickedness seems to prevail. When we focus on the wickedness happening around us, it will distort our mind, deceive our hearts, discourage our spirits, and derail our walk with Christ. In this sermon, we will be reminded not to fear in the face of evil but instead put our confidence and find peace in the person, power and presence of our Lord Jesus Christ who is worthy of trust.
